



São Paulo Research Foundation (FAPESP) postdoctoral fellowship at the Institute of Chemistry of the University of São Paulo

The Neuroscience Laboratory at the Institute of Chemistry of the University of São Paulo, invites applications for a 12-month postdoctoral fellowship funded by FAPESP (São Paulo Research Foundation) under the supervision of Prof. Henning Ulrich.

This fellowship is part of a larger research endeavor within the thematic FAPESP grant. The project shall investigate the effects of caffeine and adenosine receptors in neurogenesis and neuroprotection using *in vitro* stem cell models of Alzheimer's disease.

Requirements for the candidate:

We are seeking a highly motivated candidate who has obtained a **doctorate degree in** Biological Sciences within the last 7 years and has a **strong publication record**. Experience in cell culture and **neurodifferentiation** is essential, while proficiency in immunostaining, cytometry, biochemistry and molecular biology techniques would be advantageous.

Selection criteria:

Candidates will be selected in an open competition and will be contacted via email to arrange interviews.
